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External Accounts

- > Log into your GTE Online Banking, click Payments, then click External Accounts and List of Accounts
- > When you reach this page, click Create External Account and click I Accept
- > Input your institution's routing and account number, and hit submit
- > Within a week, you will receive two small deposits to that account.
- > When the deposits have been made, come back to the GTE Online Banking External Accounts section and verify the dollar amount and date of the two deposits.
- > This will link up your account with GTE Online Banking, and will allow you to pay the loan directly from that account by ACH, which may take a few days but will cost you nothing and barely any time!

One Time Transfer from an External Account
